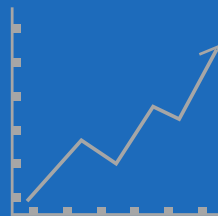

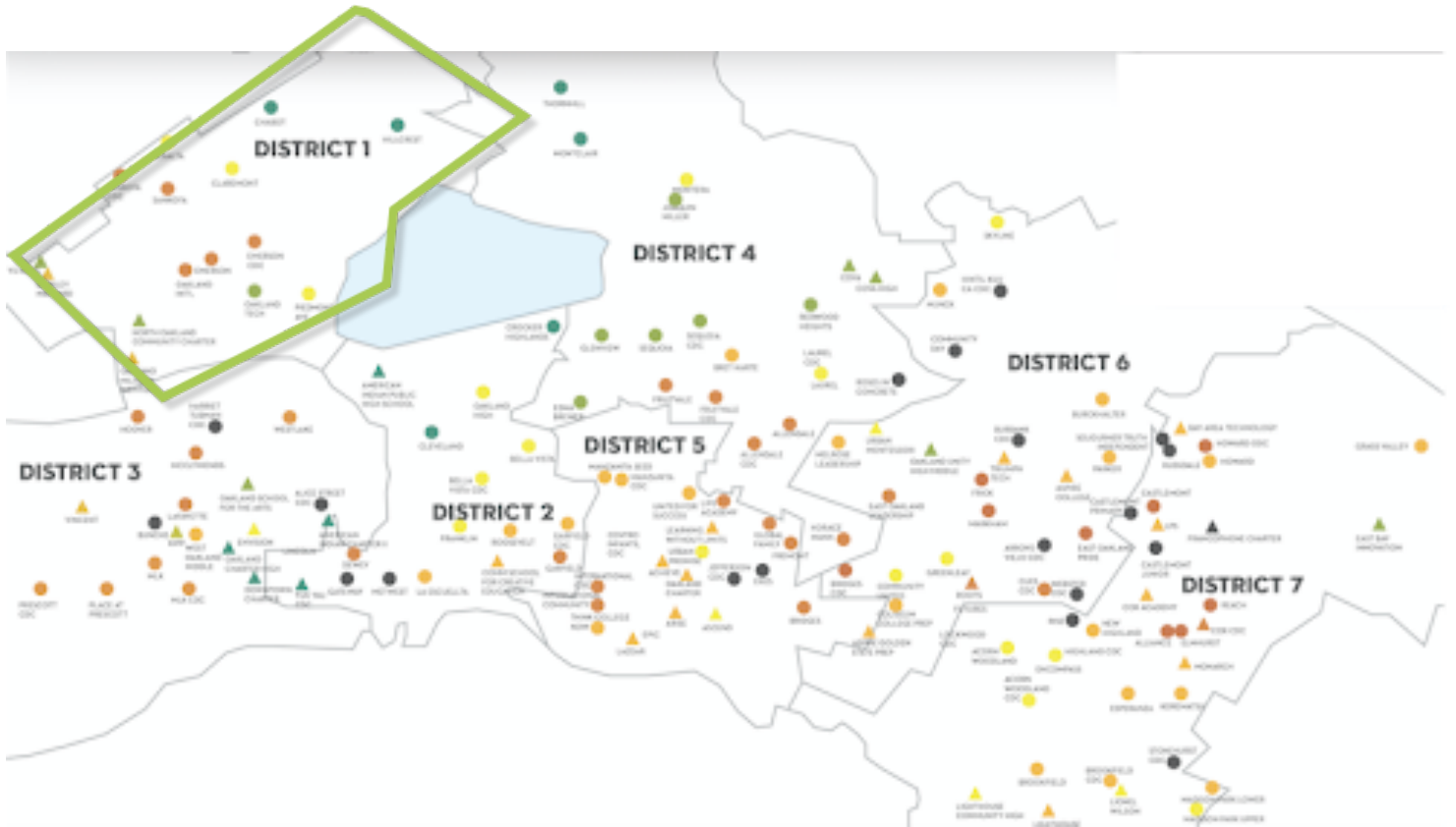

There are a few schools that are truly beating the odds and setting their low-income Black and Latino/a students up for a brighter future. But as a city, we are overall failing to provide these students with the opportunities they deserve. We need bold, radical changes to shift this reality.

Oakland Unified - **District 1**



This data brief, originally published in January 2020, highlights how Oakland schools are performing for Black and Latino students with a specific lens focusing on the schools in Board District 1. This brief examines student proficiency (how well are students mastering grade-level content?) and CORE growth scores (how well are students growing and learning each year based on where their individual starting points?).

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, state testing was canceled in the 2019-20 school year. This means this data in this brief, from the 18-19 school year, is still the most updated information available about how well schools are impacting student learning. This means that some schools on the list may have since been merged or closed. We hope OUSD will continue to release more updated data about student learning to help inform instruction and policy decisions, even (and especially) in the midst of a pandemic that is threatening student learning of our most marginalized groups of students.

District 1 schools serve 7,677 students, or 14% of all public school students in Oakland.
